Open House at the Kentucky Baptist Convention building as well as a Louisville Ministries Tour are two special features included in this year's meeting plans.



We are pleased to welcome **Kaye Miller**, National WMU President, back to Kentucky. Kaye was with us in 2006 and we are glad to have her with us again to bring the theme interpretation in each session. Kaye is an MK and the author of the 2009-10 WMU emphasis book, *Called to Love*. Her heartwarming stories will challenge you to love God and love others.

Kentucky missionaries from three continents will join us this year. **Karen Wright**, Chile; **David & Linda Jackson**, West Africa; and a **Last Frontier** missionary to Asia will be sharing stories about their work. In addition, **Susan Hatfield**, will share about the work of Baptist Global Response and the Home Health Buckets that Kentucky Baptists have helped to send to Africa.

Roxanne Nanney from First Baptist Church, Brandenburg will lead our music. Ensembles from Westport Road Baptist Church will sing on Friday evening and Saturday morning. The Korean Ladies Choir from New Life Baptist Church will sing on Friday evening.

Heritage Fund Luncheon Honoring Pat Reaves:

The work of Kentucky WMU will be featured in the Friday afternoon session. **Tim Bender**, Kentucky missionary working with the deaf, will speak during the Eliza Broadus Offering emphasis. We will hear a report from our Executive Director, and elect officers and the Executive Board for 2010-11. **Peggy Hicks** will lead the installation of officers and board members. We will also bid farewell to **Brenda Price** who is retiring from Kentucky WMU after 27 1/2 years on our staff.



From 3-5:30 p.m. Friday, there will be much to do. **Conferences** will be offered at Westport Road Baptist Church (3-4 p.m.). At the KBC Building, there will be **Open House** and a **Reception** honoring Brenda Price and Kaye Miller (3-5:30 p.m.). All parents of international missionaries are invited to the **Missionary Parents Fellowship** meeting at 4 p.m.



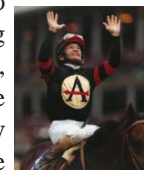

Our program concludes with Welcoming the World to Kentucky as we focus on Kentucky ministries during the 2010 FEI Altech World Equestrian Games. **Pat Day**, a Christian award winning jockey and representative of Racetrack Chaplaincy of America, will join **Larry Martin** and **LaRaine Rice** in sharing the importance of these games and our ministries.
