

# Mission Adventure Camp Information for Parents

## **Why should I send my child to Mission Adventure Camp?**

What better way to learn about missions than through a fun, camp setting with others? Campers are encouraged to grow in their relationship with Christ through worship, Bible study, a daily quiet time and making friends. Mission Adventure campers also meet missionaries, pray for missionaries, learn how the Gospel is shared in a different culture and participate in mission projects. This summer we will learn about missionaries who accept the "Missions Challenge" to spread the Gospel around the world!

## **WHAT types of camps are offered?**

Mission Adventure Camp offers **three** camping opportunities:

**MISSION ADVENTURE CAMP FOR BOYS AND GIRLS** for girls and boys in grades 3-6 and their church chaperones. Campers will enjoy worship designed with kids in mind. Girls and boys will participate in adventure recreation and fellowships together. Small group Bible studies and devotions will be held in cabins. Special activities will be offered to meet the interests of both boys and girls. Camper will learn about missions throughout the camp week.

**MOTHER/DAUGHTER OVERNIGHTS** are camps for mothers and their daughters in grades 1-3. Mothers and daughters grow closer to each other while they strengthen their relationships with God. Campers are encouraged to be "on mission" with their families. Campers will visit with a missionary, do crafts, swim, study the Bible and more!

**FATHER/SON OVERNIGHTS** are camps for fathers and their sons in grades 1-3. Fathers and sons can form special bonds as they strengthen their relationships with God. Campers are encouraged to be "on mission" with their families. Campers will visit a missionary, swim, study the Bible and learn camp craft.

## **WHERE is camp?**

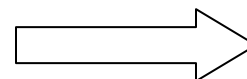
All camps and overnights take place at Cedar Crest on the beautiful grounds of Cedarmore Camp and Conference Center in Bagdad, Kentucky. Participants stay in air-conditioned cabins with bath facilities. **Campers stay with their church groups in gender-specific cabins.**

## **WHO leads camp?**

Mission Adventure Camps are staffed with a camp director and college-age young men and women. Each staff member leads Bible study, worship, and devotions. Staff members also direct special activities, such as recreation, nature and crafts. A certified lifeguard serves on staff. All staff members receive pre-camp training.

## **WHAT ELSE do I need to know?**

Because of busy schedules and limited access, campers will not be able to use cell phones or the camp phone. The camp director will contact parents if a situation necessitates. If parents need to reach a camper in the event of an emergency, they are asked to contact the camp director at (502) 655-2867. **All electronic entertainment should be left at home.** We'll have plenty of entertainment at camp!

**HOW MUCH does camp cost?**

- Weeklong camps are \$195 if registrations are received by May 25, 2012 and \$215 after this date.
- Mother/Daughter and Father/Son Overnights are \$50 per person if received by May 25, 2012 and \$60 per person after this date.

**Are SCHOLARSHIPS available?**

Partial "Love in Action" scholarships are available for those campers who may be in need of assistance. Kentucky WMU makes these scholarships available on a first-come, first-served basis.
