for Kentucky State Missions, Special Ministries, and Missions Education 2011-12 OFFERING ALLOCATIONS

Kentucky Baptist Convention **\$845,000**

Missions Growth / Church Planting 349,000

Includes funding for salary and insurance benefits for associational missionaries (\$250,000); Church Planting (\$64,000); Equestrian ministries (\$10,000); and Baptist Fellowship Center in Louisville (\$25,000).

Multi-ethnic Missions & Ministries 121,000

Ministries to various language and ethnic groups in Kentucky, including deaf ministry (\$101,000); Hispanic Bible Institute (\$10,000); and Hispanic events (\$10,000)

Missions Service & Ministries 164,000

Includes funds for appointed missionary personnel serving poor communities of Kentucky (\$100,000); Church and Community outreach initiatives (\$20,000); Missions Mobilization (\$30,000); Literacy Conference (\$1,000); Retreat for NAMB Career Appointed and NAMB Mission Service Corps missionaries serving in Kentucky (\$3,000); Mountain Missions Baptist Centers building repairs (\$10,000)

Evangelism 69,000

Understanding Other Beliefs Conferences (\$8,000); Find It Here (\$53,000); Evangelism Training (\$8,000)

Collegiate/Young Adult Ministry 105,000

Includes Kentucky Student Summer Missions (\$30,000); Reach Out Campus Revivals (\$5,000); Student Mission Action Projects (\$9,000); International Student Ministries (\$53,000); African-American Student Outreach (\$6,000); and Creative Ministries Festival (\$2,000).

Baptist Men on Mission / Disaster Relief 37,000

Includes Disaster Relief (\$28,000); Kentucky Changers (\$2,000); Baptist Builders (\$2,000); and Criminal Justice Ministries (\$5,000).

Kentucky Baptist Associations & Special Ministries **\$135,000**

All Kentucky Baptist Associations will be given a ministry grant of \$500.

Additional requests for Special Ministries Funds may be made through an application process.

Kentucky Baptist affiliated ministries may apply, including ministries of associations, MSC missionaries, etc.

The deadline for submitting an EBO allocation request for the 2011-12 offering is December 15, 2011.

Kentucky WMU **\$270,000**

Missions Education, Leader Training, Missions Events, Resource Materials 122,615

Includes training events for church & associational missions leaders, Resource Team training, and travel expenses for missions education training. Events include Kentucky WMU Annual Meeting, Exalt (State Acteens Conference), Youth on Mission Night, Women on Mission Retreats, Children in Action Missions Day Camp, and GA JAM. Area of work also includes associational, age-level, language and general missions education development.; Baptist Nursing Fellowship; and Collegiate Missions Education.

Missions Camps & Overnights 58,035

Includes staff, missionaries, recreation expenses, and materials for Mission Adventure Camp at Cedar Crest (camps and overnights); camp scholarships for needy children; Mother/Daughter Overnight, GA Overnight, and Acteens Splash at Jonathan Creek.

Promotion & Season of Prayer 87,550

Includes State Missions Season of Prayer Materials and Video, *Kentucky Notes*, *Associational Newsletter*, Year Book Supplement/Calendar, joint promotion with other KBC agencies, and the Kentucky WMU Executive Board.

Missions Education Scholarships & Internships 1,800

Seminary Field Education, Simmons Bible College, Campus Women on Mission Facilitator Scholarships.
