As I teach in my small, rural church and look at the sweet faces of my Mission Friends, I can't help but wonder if there is a future Andrew in our midst. Even if none of them become a vocational missionary, I want all of them to grow up seeking and finding their role within the mission of God.



THE SECOND EPISTLE OF PAUL, THE APOSTLE

TIMOTHY

CHAPTER 1

PAUL, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in Christ Jesus,
2 To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.
3 I thank God, whom I serve from my forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day.
4 Greatly desiring to see thee, being hindered of thy years, that I may be filled with joy.
5 When I call to remembrance the undefiled faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandfather Levi, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.
6 Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.
7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
8 He not thou therefore ashamed of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God.

9 Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began.
10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.
11 Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.
12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.
13 Held fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.
14 That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.
15 That thou knowest that all they which are in Asia be turned away from me; of whom are Phileas and Hieronymus.
16 The Lord give mercy unto thee, as thou hast often done, and thou shalt be enriched with his grace.

Conduct to praise and thank

17 But, when he was in Rome, he sought me out very diligently, and found me.
18 The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day: and in how many things he hath ministered unto me at Ephesus, thou knowest very well.

CHAPTER 2

THOU therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.
2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.
3 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.
4 No man that warreth contendeth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.
5 And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.
6 The husbandman that laboureth must be first partaker of the fruit.
7 Consider what I say, and the Lord give thee understanding in all things.
8 Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel.
9 Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evildoer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound.
10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him.

12 If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us.
13 If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.
14 Of these things put thou in remembrance, charging them before the subjecting of the heavenly approval unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

15 Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
16 But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.
17 And their word will eat as doth a canker of whom is Hymeneus and Philetus.
18 Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.
19 Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.
20 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.
21 If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.
22 They also which have thus followed righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.


POVERTY: DIFFICULT TRUTHS

In this one-hour simulation, participants will live out real-life scenarios and choices on how to navigate life without adequate transportation, affordable child care, access to medical care, and enough food to feed their families. Participants will learn about poverty and have an opportunity to reflect on their experiences and learn how they can minister to those in poverty. This is an excellent activity to use when your church focuses on Global Hunger Relief.

CWJC OF MADISON COUNTY, ALABAMA



Christian Women's Job Corps of Madison County, Alabama, provides intensive courses that include Bible study and computer classes completely free of charge. Each student is assigned a mentor, and each mentor is committed to a one-on-one relationship to help build the student's self-esteem, self-confidence, and skills essential to success in life and work. Through this partnership with WorldCrafts, the women are able to earn an income.





Sex trafficking is the fastest growing criminal industry. Trafficked women feed a worldwide demand for sex slaves, prostitution, and pornography. Poverty and the fear of uncertain futures leave these women vulnerable to the lure of traffickers. In the midst of the criminal world, The WellHouse fights human trafficking as it extends God's grace and creates opportunities for restoration to exploited women. Here, trafficking victims enter a safe residential environment where they receive spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical support. By purchasing a bracelet or necklace created by a human trafficking survivor, you join the battle against exploitation and share hope, love, and courage.



EDEN MINISTRIES

In many areas of South Asia, women are not valued. Those who are unable to care for themselves and whose families develop debt bondage are vulnerable to exploitation in the sex trafficking industry. Eden Ministries exists to restore these helpless victims. Many of the women rescued by this artisan group cannot read or write. Many did not attend school past second grade. Recognizing that economic empowerment is one of the best ways to bring security to these young women, Eden Ministries is happy to offer life-giving wages, providing women the opportunity to complete counseling and vocational training as they support their families and pay off debts.






THAI COUNTRY TRIM

The fair wage they earn through their work at Thai Country Trim offers both physical and spiritual transformation to individual women, their families, and their communities.

MULLY CHILDREN'S FAMILY

Mully Children's Family Vocational Training Centre in Yatta (Kenya) was created to restore young women broken by exploitation. Each year, the training center rescues about 100 victims out of this cruel bondage.

When they arrive at the training center, these women receive counseling and learn vocational skills, computer training, and family care. They are also disciplined in developing lives marked by eternal hope. Through their partnership with WorldCrafts, the artisans at the training center earn a fair wage for creating beautifully handcrafted purses and jewelry. The crafters' dignity is being restored as they learn their own great worth.



AFRICAN PENNANT BANNER

MORE THAN SPARROWS

The income earned from crafting enables artisans to leave prostitution while continuing to meet the day-to-day needs of their families. The women also participate in weekly lessons about spiritual matters, literacy, small business planning, parenting, and health.



RAHAB'S ROPE

Mary grew up in an orphanage in India with a bleak outlook for her future. When time came for her to leave the orphanage, she was deceived by an offer of marriage and found herself instead in a brothel. She escaped and tried to commit suicide multiple times, the last time by eating glass. A member of Rahab's Rope artisan group found her dying in the street and brought her to the center. Many young women like Mary have found a lifeline at Rahab's Rope, where they discover new opportunities while making handcrafted items.

INDIAN MOSAIC FRAMES


Each unique frame is made of recycled multicolored pieces of broken glass by Indian women employed at Rahab's Rope whose lives have been shattered by the tragedy of sex trafficking. As the women who make each frame heal physically, spiritually, and emotionally, they become new, beautiful creations. Glass is smooth, not sharp.








DISPLACED: SEEKING HOME


A United States-based refugee and displaced person simulation.
