## Prayer Stations

### Instructions

Help your kids understand the dimensions of prayer with the acronym ACTS (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication). Children will learn to praise and thank God in addition to making requests of God. They will learn to be specific in their requests by praying for guidance, help, healing, salvation, and the world. They will also learn the importance of asking forgiveness.

As children complete "Confession," be sensitive to those children who have not professed faith in Christ. Instead of writing something they are sorry for, as the teacher, you can talk about the plan of salvation and our need for forgiveness.

#### **To set up the Prayer Stations:**

- Print "Prayer Stations" posters.
- Print "Supplication" posters.
- Prepare an alphabet poster for each group. Write the letters of the alphabet down the sides of each poster.
- Gather: white paper or poster board, colored pencils or markers, Bibles, notebook paper or index cards
- For the Supplication Station, provide small reminders, such as compasses, white paper flags, small adhesive bandages, crosses, and globe key chains.
