Missions Lesson Christmas in August Gift Packing Party

August, Week 4

Objective: Girls and boys will pack gifts for a Christmas in August missionary.

Materials: Christmas CD, CD player, hot chocolate, Christmas in August gifts, self-sealing plastic bags, mailing boxes, packing material, packing tape, gift tags, construction paper, markers, gift bows, straws, masking tape, hot chocolate

Preparation:

Use masking tape to mark "Start" and "Finish" lines on the floor.

Procedure:

- 1. Ask kids to share what they remember about the first Christmas in August and the Christmas in August missionary you selected.
- 2. Play Christmas music.
- 3. Explain that we will be packing the gifts to send to the missionary.
- 4. Instruct kids to sort the gifts by grouping similar items. Put liquid items in selfsealing plastic bags.
- 5. Give each child a piece of construction paper and markers. Direct kids to make Christmas cards of encouragement for the missionary.
- 6. Pack the sorted items into boxes. Add the Christmas cards with a note about your project. Tape and address each box.
- 7. Invite kids to gather around the boxes. Ask a different child to pray for each box. Give each kid a gift tag. Ask them to write the name of your Christmas in August missionary on the tag. Kids can take this home as a reminder to pray for the missionary.
- 8. Gift Bow Relay: Form two teams. Explain that the teams will have a relay race to get all of their teams' bows to the finish line. Give each kid a drinking straw and a bow. At your signal, teams will race to blow their bows to the finish line.
- 9. Serve hot chocolate. This would be a good time to discuss Christmas mission projects your group could do.

After the lesson, mail the packages to your Christmas in August missionary. 😊
