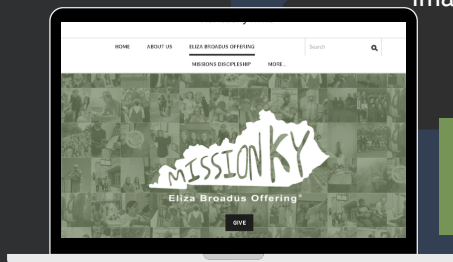

Associational Grants awarded in 2022 | \$25,000

The Eliza Broadus Offering provides monetary support for our Kentucky Baptist Associations to be used for ministry/ evangelism, expenses such as Bibles, tracts, and other supplies; for missions education; or for events which will promote training or support for ministry/evangelism.

This year 50 Associations/Networks received a \$500 grant to be used associational missions for the total of \$25,000.
