



KENTUCKY WMU ENGAGES DISCIPLES OF JESUS TO OBEDIENTLY FULFILL GOD'S MISSION.

» Hello! - from the EDT

hank you for your partnership in missions! Over the last year, you have allowed Kentucky WMU to walk alongside you as you reach Kentucky and the world for Christ.

The Eliza Broadus Offering for State Missions has continued to see consistency in giving despite the challenges of giving during a pandemic. Together, we were able to support missions efforts with \$1,130,304. Your generous gifts impacted over 200 mission and ministry opportunities across Kentucky. You helped provide to churches and associations The Gospel To Every Home resources, Freedom Forever Ministries in Paducah engaged new opportunities to reach incarcerated and at-risk women with life-changing hope, and enabled Re:Center Ministries in Louisville to continue ministering to the homeless and hurting. The current theme for the offering is One True Hope and we appreciate your partnership as we move toward the \$1.25 million goal for 2021-2022.

Since the Fall of 2020, we have helped you start 8 new missions discipleship groups as a way to encourage your congregations to learn, pray, give, and engage in missions. As we continue to offer online training and leadership discussion groups, such as Leadership Matters, we are excited about a renewed interest requesting inperson leader training and resources to start new missions groups. We also held townhall meetings with our Associational WMU to hear and share about changes within the work of WMU both at the national and state levels. These townhall sessions allowed for an open environment to share challenges and strengthen one another in leadership.

In 2021, we launched our first annual Changers Kids and sent children and their leaders to serve at 7 locations across the Commonwealth. Four

of the 7 ministry sites were EBO recipients. We engaged 63 kids and 24 chaperones to serve these ministry centers through sorting clothes, landscaping, working in the food pantry, and light construction. Students also gathered at Kentucky Changers July 10-16 to serve Greensburg and surrounding communities. Although we took precautions and hosted only 1 location, we are praising the Lord and excited to report 4 students and 1 homeowner put their trust in Christ! We look forward to hosting more Changers locations in 2022.

Kentucky WMU women joined together to support the work of WMU in Montana. We were challenged by the National WMU Foundation to support a "new work" state reach their \$24,000 goal. We helped Montana by helping them surpass their goal with \$25,091.44.

As you continue to be obedient to God's plan, we commit to be your champions as you engage in missions. As we adjust, we grow, learn new perspectives, teach, and encourage others to make disciples. Thank you for walking alongside Kentucky WMU as we remain faithful to engaging disciples of Jesus to live on mission in Kentucky and throughout the world.

Wanda also provided a Thursday night leadership meeting giving us encouragement during this difficult time. Liz and all of the staff created an Annual Celebration virtually so that we could still hear from our missionaries and enjoy some workshops. This has given us an online presence that we did not have before but had talked about the need for many times.

National WMU faced the same challenges; What do we do and how do we do it? Subscriptions plummeted because churches were not having children's classes on Wednesday nights and that affected the operating income. How were they going to absorb this financial impact? All board meetings have been conducted via zoom, saving money in travel expenses. They offered another VRA for those that wanted to retire. They are doing pre-orders for new world craft items so that they will not have money tied up in products just sitting on the shelves. National WMU consolidated GA, RA, and CA material into one unit which helped to cut printing costs. They also realized that we do not need a huge facility in order to conduct business anymore and listed the property for sale. These past few years have been difficult and challenging but God has guided all the way.

The theme for this year's Annual Celebration is "To do justly, love mercy, and to walk humbly with our God". These last couple of years have really brought this scripture to life for me. When all this started and we were having to make decisions about canceling an event or going on with it, we had to do justly. Meaning that we had to put all of our trust in God and let Him guide our decisions. So many times we want to do things our way without allowing God to guide us and that, my friends, is where we mess up horribly. So how do you love mercy when we are all isolated from each other? Showing affection without human contact can be tough but we were able to overcome that by sharing encouraging scripture on social media, and sending cards and emails to help lift each other's spirits. God gave us this time to stop and slow down so that we could walk humbly with Him. He allowed us to see what was truly important; God, family, and friends. God did not create us to be hermits, He created us to have fellowship and relationships with one another and especially with Him. - 1. GA JAM Our theme was "Mission Vision: Keep Looking to Jesus!" Before the virtual meeting, GA leaders were able to download workshops like crafts, cooking, science, and mission projects. Our "host" church was Buck Run Baptist. They did a wonderful job recording songs, skits, and the GA Pledge and Motto! On November 6th, Melissa Logsdon-Young, Melanie Jones, and Stacy Nall broadcasted live from Kentucky WMU studios! Over 30 GAs joined us for missionary interviews, songs, skits, and a game.
- 2.Gospel to Every Home Kentucky WMU members went door to door after the 2021 Annual Meeting and connected with 150 families in Shelby County.
- 3. Missions Celebration & Annual Meeting
 Over 250 women and men gathered in
 Shelbyville to learn what it means to live
 "Relentlessly" on mission with God. We
 heard from Nik & Ruth Ripken, Andrew Mann,
 JoAnn Lira, and Nelle Thomas. We were led
 in worship by Justin & Hollye Hornsby and
 witnessed the commissioning of 16 KY MSC
 missionaries.
- 4. Fall Women's Retreat Women from across Kentucky, gathered together at Cecilia Baptist Church in Cecilia on September 18th and explored Psalm 119:103. The theme was "Living the Sweet Life." Women enjoyed five workshops and a WorldCrafts Market.

5. Online WOM

Leaders - We engaged,
on average, 12 women
with an online monthly missions
discipleship group. This group
functioned as an online community for
leaders without a local group.

- 6. Changers Kids 63 Children and their leaders were able to do handson missions in seven different locations across Kentucky: Louisville, Covington, Hopkinsville, Henderson, Strunk, Lexington, and Campbellsville. Each Saturday went by quickly, but we were able to learn about Jesus' example of serving his disciples by prayer walking, playing games, singing, and serving each ministry in multiple ways.
- 7. Kentucky Changers Students also gathered July 10-16 to serve Greensburg and surrounding communities. Although we took precautions and hosted only 1 location, we are praising the Lord and excited to report 4 students and 1 homeowner put their trust in Christ.
- 8. Adult Changers WMU mobilized 16 men and women to serve at the Old School House in Paintlick. Work included installing new light fixtures, adding wainscotting, painting the hallways, installing a new water heater and shower heads, and shining up a portion of the gym floor.
