If your team is small, you may be paired with another team.

Once we receive your completed registration, we will send information about your assigned ministry as quickly as possible, however, your assignment is not firm until a few weeks prior to your trip. You will receive contact information for the local person who is responsible for your assigned ministry. This person will give you detailed information on the ministry and preparations for your team. Your team may need to provide materials to conduct the ministry (such as tools for construction related ministries; crafts for backyard Bible clubs, etc.) Upon arrival, you will receive maps and directions to your ministry site.

Each team is responsible for its own transportation to/from/and during the ministry experience.

_____ **Light construction/repairs**

Providing construction expertise and possibly materials for churches and/or houses in the communities where you serve. (Both skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled volunteers.)

_____ **Block Parties**

Sharing Christ with communities through creative evangelism.

_____ **Servant Ministries**

Sharing Christ through acts of kindness while meeting the needs of others. Some examples include passing out water bottles in a designated area; canvassing a neighborhood and providing free items from a local church/ministry; working in a ministry distribution center sorting items; clean-up and beautification of public and private sites; making bracelets; etc.

_____ **Prayerwalking**

Prayer onsite with direction and intentionality. Prayer is VITAL in all we do.

_____ **Health and Wellness**

Nurses and other medical professionals leading health and wellness fairs in various locations and at block parties.

_____ **Sports Camps**

Daily basketball camps to work on basketball skills and share the gospel with children and adults that are participating.

_____ **Elder care**

Provide compassion services to seniors residing in nursing home or assisted living.
