*During the 2013 week of prayer for state missions, pray for...*

**Sunday • Luke 8:4-5**...ministries which intentionally take the gospel out of the church and into the community...people who aren't receptive to the gospel and for ministries that touch and prepare them to receive it...ministries to the deaf across Kentucky...more people to learn sign language and share the good news of Jesus with deaf neighbors.

**Monday • Luke 8:6**...people whose lives are rocky and difficult...ministries which demonstrate compassion and share the love of Jesus with people in need...the lives of those whose homes are repaired by Kentucky Changers to be changed through the students' work and witness...the students who participate in Kentucky Changers to grow spiritually through this missions experience.

**Tuesday • Luke 8:7**...ministry at the Kentucky Speedway and that the families who are drawn to Pit Stop Challenge will be receptive to the gospel...the witness of Pit Stop Challenge volunteers not to be choked out by race weekend activities, personal problems or other distractions...the successful distribution of Bibles and other Christian literature at the Speedway and other venues.

**Wednesday • Luke 8:8**...Engage, an outreach event of Baptist Campus Ministry for international students...the good soil of receptive hearts among these students and that Engage participants this coming November will understand the gospel and receive it with joy...the seeds planted here to yield a hundredfold crop all over the world as students who have accepted Christ bear witness in their home countries.

**Thursday • Luke 8:9-10**...the minds and hearts of those who have no understanding of the gospel message to be opened...those who bully and treat others in an abusive manner, and those who are the victims of bullying...more Christian students to befriend other students and not be a part of the problem...the churches, schools and families who are addressing this situation in our communities.

**Friday • Luke 8:11-12**...High Equine Mountain Outreach and other Kentucky equestrian ministries which plant the seed of the Word of God, and for the children and youth who are being touched through them...Cowboy churches and their efforts to reach the lost through worship services in equestrian-friendly settings...those who share The Simple Plan of the Master Horseman and that this gospel tract will successfully sow God's seed.

**Saturday • Luke 8:13-14**...those planting churches across Kentucky to have wisdom and help in preparing the "soil" of those who are lost in their communities...those who receive the Word and that it won't be choked out by life's worries, riches or pleasures...newly-planted churches to grow and plant other churches.

**Sunday • Luke 8:15**...Kentucky missionaries, Baptist associations and Directors of Missions...the impact of the Eliza Broadus Offering on missions in your association...the ministries of these KBC teams: Evangelism & Church Planting, Missions Mobilization and Church Consulting & Revitalization...affinity evangelism efforts across our state, that this would be good soil for sharing the gospel.
